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Cut out these key facts for recycling glass and stick them up at home.

Bottles and jars can be recycled over and over again, and they will still be as good as new.



It costs less money to recycle glass than to take it to landfill.



Lots of glass is still not being recycled what a waste!



Using recycled glass is better for our planet as it doesn't give off as much CO2 gasses which are bad for the environment.



Recycling just 2 glass jars saves the same amount of energy needed to heat your oven to bake a cake.



ALL glass jars can be recycled.



Bottles and jars are the easiest materials to recycle.
